# Gene Sharp Emeritus Treasurer Co-Chair

#### In Gene's own words:

If I can remember back to the late 60's, I joined the PMA (Purchasing Management Association), which later became NAPM (National Association of Purchasing Management) and into the 21st century (wow, that really makes me seem old) where we are now as ISM-Wichita!

After studying a year and a half at WU (yes, before they added the "S") they decided to change their catalogue which would force me to start my education all over, so I went to work at Frontier Chemical as a clerk in 1959.

In '62, I joined the U.S. Army and became a construction surveyor for three years and went back to civilian status in January 1965 and went back to Vulcan Chemicals (they got



bought out and changed the name) as inventory control in their storeroom/warehouse and moved to Buyer position when it opened and joined PMA.

In 1970, I went to Litwin Engineering & Construction as a Purchasing Agent of all materials needed to build refineries or chemical plants until 1983 when they terminated their procurement department and moved to Houston (that's another story for a different time).

While at Litwin I achieved my C.P.M. certification which was instrumental in landing me a job with Boeing and I became an aircraft parts Buyer!

My first experience with the NAPM Board was in 1978 when I volunteered for Pro-D Committee to award scholarships and have been on the Board ever since progressing to Pro-D Chair, 2nd VP, 1st VP, President (2 times), Executive Director (5 times), then as Treasurer, and now as Emeritus Member!

After 16 years at Boeing, I was caught in a work force reduction without having 20 years of service! A few weeks later, John Rice called and asked if I would like to become contract labor for Cessna, so for 5 1/2 years with a few interruptions that's something that worked out well. My last employer was Dakota Moon Enterprises as contract labor working with Boeing in Tulsa!

The last part of the story is the connection with the Wichita Industrial Trade Show as a Past President of NAPM/ISM and representing our organization I volunteered as Advertising Chair on the WITS Board and then became Co-Chairman in 2006 and wrapped up my ninth show a couple of weeks ago for 2023! What a ride! I think I have recruited a new WITS replacement, but that's another story! Thanks for the opportunities!

#### How it works:

- In the center of the room are items that would make a great second gift, like a book or used toy.
- A runner then takes the gifts to a numbered table where there is wrapping paper and supplies with a Santa Bag.
- Parents can leave with presents wrapped and ready to go in Santa bags for Christmas that they selected for their children. It is a beautiful way to provide dignity through choice.
